Representative Webb made a conceptual motion to amend to restrict the bill to prescheduled services. Representative Acheson seconded. The motion carried. Representative Fry moved to pass SB 199 favorably as amended. Representative Acheson seconded. The motion carried.</u>

Turning to HCR 5048--Kansas water office memorialized to negotiate a sormwater management compact with Missouri, Representative Spaniol made a motion to report the Resolution favorably for passage. Representative Acheson seconded. Motion carried.

Regarding HCR 5051—Abandonment and plugging of oil wells; corporation commission powers; moratorium, Representative Rezac, seconded by Representative Patterson, moved to report the Resolution favorably.
