The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ron Fox, who also made some announcements.

Senate Bill 119--Membership of director of Kansas fish and game commission on Kansas water authority.

Representative Patterson, seconded by Representative Patrick, moved to place Senate Bill 119 on the table for discussion and possible action. The motion carried.

Representative Charlton, seconded by Representative Patterson, moved to amend Senate Bill 119 to include the Chairman of the Kansas Corporation Commission. It was noted that these would be non-voting, ex officio members of the Water Authority. The motion carried.

Representative Shore, seconded by Representative Patrick, made a motion to remove the Director of the Fish and Game Commission on the basis that this was a non-consumptive use of water. Representative Patterson opposed this amendment because each of the basins had a person on the committee who was considered a "fish and game type of individual." He felt it was equally important that the Director of the Fish and Game Commission be retained on the Water Authority for counsel and advice, since he would be a non-voting member. A vote was taken and division called for; there were 5 in favor and 7 opposed. The motion failed.

Representative Sughrue, seconded by Representative Sutter, made a motion to report Senate Bill 119 favorably as amended.

Representative Shore moved, seconded by Representative Mollenkamp, to table Senate Bill 119. The motion failed.

A vote was taken on the original motion to report Senate Bill 119 favorably as amended. Division was called for; 12 were in favor and 4 opposed. motion carried.

There was informal discussion of the Substitute for House Bill 3112 and proposed floor amendments.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:50 p.m.
