Chairman called meeting to order, noting that a balloon copy of SB 179 had been distributed to each member. He said that it supposedly has been agreed upon by all parties concerned, so we shall see if this is the case when hearings begin on SB 179.

He noted that briefings will be held this day on several bills, and invited Ms. Correll, and Mr. Furse to begin staff briefings.

SB 179:

Emalene Correll began by saying it best that committee look at original bill during the briefing rather than the copy of balloon in front of them. SB 179 comes to you after considerable work by Senate PH&W committee, she said, and has had extensive amendments made to it. This creates a new act which prohibits persons other than licensed registered nurses certified as nurse anesthetists under the new act, persons licensed to practice medicine and surgery, and licensed dentists from administering general or regional anesthesia. She gave a comprehensive over-view of the language of the bill. The bill was requested by the Kansas Association of Nurse Anesthetists, and was supported by the Kansas Medical Society and the Kansas Hospital Association, although there were some concerns about some of the issues therein. There have not been any changes made in the proposed amendments that were in hand-out of balloon this date.

This bill contains the term certified registered nurse anethetist, (CRNS), but the problem is the term certified is not going to fit into our credentialing system.

She explained the definitions and distinction between licensing and registration. Physician's Assistants are registered and that is nothing but protection of title. M.D.'s, D.O.'s. Chiropractors, etc., on the other hand have exclusive practice rights by licensure.

Chairman at this point strongly urged members to study the balloon copy of SB 179 before hearings begin at tomorrow's meeting. (See Attachment No.2) for balloon on SB 179.

There were numerous questions from members at this point in regard to SB 179.

HB 2663 Briefing:

Revisor Norman Furse addressed members on HB 2663, saying it is a result of Interim Committee study on credentialing. The Interim was directed to look at the whole general credentialing process. After extensive hearings, some proposals were formed, i.e., certification was added to the statutes by the Interim Committee to help clarify the meaning of this term. He explained the bill very comprehensively section by section.

"Registration" means the process by which the state identifies and lists on an official roster those persons who meet predetermined qualifications and who will be the only persons permitted to use a designated title. Registration protects only the title.

"Licensure" is the highest level of credentialing, and it is granted to those who meet predetermined qualifications to engage in an occupation or profession. Licensure protects the scope of practice as well as the title.

He explained appointment of technical committee and their duties, the final report given by the Secretary when relating to credentialing application. In section 6, there were 9 subsections in all, and he was thorough in explanation of these. He spoke of the very good testimony given to Interim Committee this summer, and their work in forming standards on credentialing.

HB 2664 Briefing:

Ms. Correll stated this bill is to basically suggest this bureau of child research may aid and cooperate on the request of Secry. of SRS to assist in the administration or operation of any institution within the department of SRS. Programs from Winfield and Parsons have been very beneficial, and if on-going will be great for resources to draw from in this area.

HB 2492 Briefing:

Ms. Correll explained this bill deals with the penalties or way in which violations of the law or rules and regulations that relate to Adult Care Homes are handled. Currently there is not the 2 step process that is spoken to in HB 2492. This sets out to assess a civil penalty to not exceed \$100 per day per deficiency noted. (This is not to exceed \$500). Amendments proposed will eliminate the second step of the issuance of a citation.

She answered questions from members in regard to time period requirements in correcting violations,

Chair noted due to lack of time this date the breifings would be stopped, and will be continued at a later date.
