The Chairman called the meeting to order and introduced Representative Sandy Duncan who was present to address HB 2734 concerning temporary rules and regulations.

Representative Duncan presented the information from HB 2734 and further testimony was given by Senator Salisbury regarding the need for this particular piece of legislation.

A motion was made by Senator Francisco and seconded by Senator Strick to report the bill favorable for passage. Motion carried.

Attention was then turned to HB 3102 concerning the duties of secretary of health and environment with respect to veterans exposed to chemicals. This bill was recommended by the House Governmental Organization Committee to repeal the statutes referring to the reporting of Veterans who have been exposed to certain chemicals in the Vietnam war. Current statutes say that this information was being compiled by the Department of Health and Environment and made available to the Veterans Administration and reported each year to the legislature. It was determined that all this was unnecessary because all the information is available from the Veterans Administration.

A motion was made by Senator Strick to report the bill favorable. It was seconded by Senator Hoferer and the motion carried.

The meeting was then adjourned by the Chairman.
