Chairman Apt called the meeting to order and announced hearings on $\underline{\text{HB 2109}}$ relating to pooling arrangements for insurance would not be held as the bill is $\underline{\text{still}}$ in Insurance Committee.

Representative R. D. Miller moved that HB 2139 relating to notification dates for discontinuation be brought off the table. Seconded by Representative Bill Reardon. Motion carried.

Representative Reardon moved to amend HB 2139 by adding a section to the bill to make the administrators date uniform with the teachers' dates, April 10 to May 10. Seconded by Representative R. D. Miller. Motion carried.

Representative R. D. Miller moved that HB 2139 be passed favorably as amended. Seconded by Representative Vern Williams. Motion carried.

Representative Hensley stated that the State Board of Education would revise the form (Attachment I) which is used for preparing the list for hearing committee members. The revision would allow for signatures of representatives of Kansas National Education Association and Kansas Association of School Boards. The signatures would show approval of the hearing committee member. This approval would eliminate the need for HB 2161.

The chairman commended Representative Hensley for his efforts to resolve this issue.

Representative Gene Amos moved that HB 2426, concerning the designation and training of school law enforcement officers, be passed favorably. Seconded by Representative Patrick. Motion carried.

Representative Jim Lowther requested discussion on <u>HB 2481</u> setting up a Kansas postsecondary education information program. After discussion <u>Representative Lowther made a motion to amend HB 2481 by striking Section 3 which contained provision for an advisory committee. Seconded by Representative Marvin Smith. Motion carried.</u>

A motion was made by Representative Lowther to pass out favorably as amended <u>HB 2481</u>. Seconded by Representative Jessie Branson. Motion carried. Representative Vern Williams called for a division.

The vote was 11 - 10. Representative Vern Williams and Representative Kerry Patrick wished to be recorded as voting NO.

The chair directed attention to <u>HB 2427</u> concerning bilingual education. After some discussion Representative Al Ramirez moved HB 2427 be passed favorably. Representative George Dean seconded. Motion carried. Representative Gary Blumenthal asked to be recorded voting AYE for the motion.

Discussion was held on <u>HB 2420</u> concerning special education for exceptional children; providing for appointment of education advocates for certain children.

Representative Gary Blumenthal moved HB 2420 be reported favorably for passage. Seconded by Representative George Dean.
