Since the Energy Subcommittee's meeting of February 3 was continued to February 10, they had no bills to consider.

Staff gave a brief review of the two bills heard by the Natural Resources Subcommittee on February 2.

HB 2094--Fish and game; use of .22 long-rifle cartridges. Following a short discussion period, Representative Freeman, seconded by Representative Shore, made a motion to report House Bill 2094 favorably. The motion passed. (See Attachment 1) N.R. SUB. 2/2/87

HCR 5001 -- Concurrent resolution encouraging counties to develop waterwastewater management plans. Re Proposal No. 8. Staff noted that since this is a resolution, it has no cost, but is a request that the counties require the preparation and development of these plans and submit them to the Department of Health and Environment. If the plans are developed, there will be costs which may range up to \$200,000 for certain counties to develop these plans. However, the resolution does not require the counties to do anything -- it only suggests that the county commissioners direct that the plans be developed. Representative Spaniol noted that this legislation was a follow-up to SB 482 of the 1986 Session which was a mandatory requirement and that this legis-lation had been substantially weakened and had no binding effect. (See Attachment 2)

Representative Sallee, seconded by Representative Charlton, made a motion to approve the proposed amendment on lines 30 and 31, to delete "require the development and preparation of" and add"develop and prepare." The motion carried. Representative Mollenkamp voted "no".

Representative Charlton, seconded by Representative Lacey, made a motion to report HCR 5001 favorably. The motion passed. Representative Mollenkamp voted "no." N.R. SUB. 2/2/87

No objections were made to the minutes of the Natural Resources Subcommittee meetings of January 26 and 27; therefore they were adopted. There also were no objections to the minutes of the Standing Committee's meeting of January 29 and they were adopted.
