Representative Webb made a motion to amend the bill to limit application to hepatitis and to conceptually include employer obligation for previous treatment with the medical compensation section, 44-510, of the workers' compensation act. In order for this bill to be in conformity with 44-510 of the workers' compensation act, it is the intention of the committee that this bill be effective upon publication in the statute book. Representative Patrick seconded the motion which carried.

Representative Webb made a motion to report H.B. 2578, as amended, favorably for passage. It was seconded by Representative Whiteman and passed unanimously.
