The committee heard a report from Robert Coldsnow, Legislative Counsel, including a review of the history of the Kansas Census.

Mr. Coldsnow also advised the committee that the Legislature would be subject to suit in both Federal and State couts if it fails to reapportion legislative district boundaries in 1989 as required by the Kansas Constitution.

He also reminded the committee that the three-judge panel said in a decision handed down in the fall of 1983, that although the 1979 reapportionment of the Legislature was valid, "considerable problems could arise" if the lawmakers attempted to use 1980 federal census data to reapportion in 1989.
