HB-2338 - AN ACT relating to property taxation; concerning advisory hearing panels to county boards of equalization was discussed, and Representative Rolfs explained the bill. Representative Fuller moved, second by Representative Pottorff, that HB-2338 be reported favorably.

Representative Fox proposed an amendment which would make the bill state-wide instead of applying to certain counties only. (Attachment 1) Representative Fox moved, second by Representative Reardon, that the amendment be adopted. Motion carried. There was considerable discussion whether members of the panel have to be residents of the county or whether the director of PVD should have a hand in setting forth duties of the Board. Representative Fox withdrew his motion. Representative Representative Vancrum moved, second by Representative Charlton, reconsider the amendment making HB-2338 apply state-wide. The motion passed. Representative Vancrum moved, second by Reardon, that Wyandotte, Geary, Lyon, Jewell and Shawnee counties also be included in the bill. Motion carried 10-8. Representative Leach moved, second by Representative Fox, that HB-2338 as amended be passed favorably. The motion carried.

HB-2087 - AN ACT relating to income taxation; excluding amounts received as social security benefits from adjusted gross income, was considered. Representative Fox moved, second by Representative Fuller, that  $\underline{\text{HB-2087}}$  be reported adversely. The motion carried.

HB-2283 - AN ACT relating to property taxation; concerning the authority to abate penalties for late filing of statements listing certain property, was considered. Representative Aylward moved, second by Representative Fox, that HB-2283 as that HB-2283 as amended be passed favorably. The motion passed.

The minutes of the March 5 committee meeting were approved.

There being no further business to come before the committee, the chairman adjourned the meeting.
