Secretary Harley Duncan explained HB-2591 - AN ACT relating to property taxation; concerning the taxation of certain personal property, followed by discussion and questions from committee members.

SB-167 - AN ACT concerning townships; relating to the limitation on certain tax levies, was discussed. Representative Vancrum moved, second by Representative Spaniol, to report SB-167 favorably as amended.

Representative Adam objected to the motion and explained her reasons why she thinks it is not a good idea. One reason is that townships vary widely - both in area and population. Representative Adam moved, second by Representative Grotewiel, to table SB-167. The motion lost.

Representative Wagnon moved, second by Representative Adam, to reconsider SB-167 the previous amendment to the bill. The motion lost.

After further committee discussion, Representative Leach moved, second by Representative Charlton, to table SB-167. The motion lost.

The original motion carried.

The minutes of April 1st and 2nd were approved.

The committee secretary, Millie Foose, was commended for her excellent work and a presentation was made.
