SB 420 - An act concerning special education for exceptional children; affecting the computation of the amount of state aid entitlement of school districts for the provision thereof. (Ways and Means)

Following a call to order, the Chairman explained that SB 420 would reduce the count of the special education teacher who is a paraprofessional from .5 to .4 for the purpose of state aid entitlement.
