Senate Bill 130 - Providing for only clothbound session laws.

Ron Thornburgh, Office of Secretary of State, testified his office is in favor of the bill. He stated with the modern printing methods there is not much cost differential of clothbound and paperbound. The cost is one dollar per volume more for the clothbound, which will be a slight total increase of three hundred dollars. He said there is going to be no loss of service to the people of Kansas.

Senator Feleciano moved to report the bill favorably and to request the bill be placed on the consent calendar. Senator Parrish seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senate Bill 97 - Probate procedure, allowance of demand without hearing.

The chairman reviewed the bill and the proposed amendments to the bill. Following committee discussion, Senator Feleciano moved to amend the bill in subsection (b) by changing the \$200 to \$1,000, and strike subsection (c). Senator Parrish seconded the motion. Committee discussion was held on the motion.

Senator Hoferer made a substitute motion to amend the bill by striking subsection (b); in subsection (c), change \$2,000 to \$1,000; and in lines 53 and 54 change "at the demand hearing" to "at the hearing on the petition." Senator Burke seconded the motion. Following committee discussion, the substitute motion carried. Senator Feleciano requested his "no" vote on the substitute motion be recorded in the minutes.

Senator Burke moved to report the bill favorably as amended. Senator Hoferer seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senate Bill 98 - Fiduciaries, investment standards for trustees.

Following committee discussion of the bill, <u>Senator Talkington</u> <u>moved to amend the bill by striking all of line 61 and line 62</u> <u>through the period</u>. <u>Senator Feleciano seconded the motion</u>. Following further committee discussion, <u>the motion carried</u>.

Senator Winter moved to amend the bill in line 54 by changing "which follows" to "following". Senator Hoferer seconded the motion, and the motion carried.
