Senate Bill 372 - Kansas parole board, membership, decisions.

The chairman announced since other committee members could not stay for the committee meeting, Senate Bill 372 will be delayed and brought up again within the next 10 days for discussion and consideration.

House Bill 2007 - Crimes involving aiding runaways.

The chairman explained the bills scheduled this afternoon came from the interim judiciary study committee based on recommendations of the 1985 Attorney General's Task Force on Missing and Exploited Children.

Commissioner Robert Barnum, Social Rehabilitation Services, testified the department is in support of the bill. He was a member of the task force that recommended the bill.

<u>House Bill 2008</u> - Furnishing alcohol or drugs to minors, penalties.

Commissioner Barnum stated SRS is in support of the bill.

During discussion, the chairman said he had difficulty with this bill because of potential for committing a felony crime and not knowing it.

House Bill 2010 - Definition of crime of indecent liberties with a child.

Staff explained originally the need for the bill came out of recommendations of the task force committee to cover the facts in State v. Tripp case in the Court of Appeals, in which the perpetrator encouraged the child to commit illegal acts with a third party.

Committee discussion was held on the bill.

House Bill 2012 - Missing children information clearinghouse.

Commissioner Barnum stated SRS is in support of the bill.

Mary Lou McPhail, Kansas Bureau of Investigation, testified KBI is in support of the bill. She stated there is no fiscal note to her knowledge.
