The committee discussed liability issues and the Good Samaritan Act as they relate to HB 2639.

A motion was made by Representative Schauf and seconded by Representative Baker to eliminate in Section 24, line 629 of HB 2639 the words "but such fee shall not exceed \$25.00." The motion carried.

A motion was made by Representative Mollenkamp and seconded by Representative Miller to change Section 26 (a) (3) of HB 2639 to give the board authority to set the fee. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Representative Miller and seconded by Representative Bowden to add to HB 2639 legislation the wording "to have any rules and regulations promulgated by the old board to continue in effect to January 1, 1989." The motion carried.

A motion was made by Representative Miller and seconded by Representative Graeber to grant the board subpoena powers. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Representative Baker and Seconded by Representative Brown to amend Section 12 (c) lines 366 and 367 of HB 2639 to change the wording from "10% of the qualified electors" to "5% of the qualified electors."

A substitute motion was made by Representative Dean and seconded by Representative Bowden to amend Section 12 (c), lines 366 and 367 to change the wording from "10% of the qualified electors" to "10% of those who voted for Secretary of State." The motion carried.

A motion was made by Representative Miller and seconded by Representative Schauf to conceptually adopt HB 2639 with changes made by the committee. The motion carried.
