The first bill considered was SB-453 - AN ACT relating to property taxation; effecting statutory amendments necessary and incidental to the reappraisal and classification of property for taxation purposes. The committee discussed an amendment that had been proposed.

Representative Pottorff moved, second by Representative Roe, that the amendment be adopted. The motion carried. Representative Pottorff moved, second by Representative Lowther, that SB-453 as amended be passed favorably. The motion carried.

There was discussion of HB-3015 - an act that would repeal the statutes governing the imposition of a transient guest tax by cities and counties. Representative Roe moved, second by Representative Lowther, to amend the bill to include the provisions of HB-2742 as amended by the committee. The motion carried. Representative Lowther moved, second by Representative Roe, to pass Substitute for HB-3015 favorably. The motion carried.

The minutes of March 30 and March 31 were approved.
