SENATE BILL 492

Sen. Salisbury moved to amend S.B. 492 by striking the language in lines 71-76. Sen. Parrish seconded. Motion carried. Sen. Salisbury moved to recommend S.B. 492 as amended favorably for passage. Sen. Burke seconded. Motion carried. SENATE BILL 687

Sen. Salisbury moved to amend S.B. 687 as suggested by the Revisor. (Att. 1). Sen. Parrish seconded. Motion carried.

Sen. Parrish moved that an amendment for exemption for foster care licensed homes be added to the bill. Sen. Burke seconded.

After committee discussion, <u>Sen. Parrish</u> withdrew her motion, and <u>Sen. Burke</u> withdrew his second. <u>Sen. Salisbury</u> moved that S.B. 687 be recommended favorably for passage as amended. <u>Motion carried</u>.

SENATE BILL 75

<u>Chairman Kerr</u> stated that in discussion the content of S.B. 75 with interested parties it was agreed that S.B. 75 would have very little chance of passage by itself. There is a chance that S.B. 75 could be included at the time that a comprehensive sales tax exemption bill is considered.

SENATE BILL 77

Sen. Allen moved to report S.B. 77 favorably. Sen. Mulich seconded. Motion carried.

SENATE BILL 519

Sen. Montgomery moved to amend S.B. 519 by incorporating language pertaining to the Pottawamie and Wabaunsee County library into the bill.

Sen. Karr seconded. Motion carried. Sen. Karr moved to recommend S.B. 519, as amended, favorably for passage. Sen. Montgomery seconded. Motion carried.

Chairman Kerr stated that he felt S.B. 606 and S.B.446 should be referred to an exempt committee in order that the bills will still be able to be considered.

<u>Sen. Allen</u> moved to adopt the minutes of the March 3 meeting. <u>Sen. Mulich</u> seconded. <u>Motion carried.</u>
