MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION

SB 525 - School districts, budgets per pupil, limitations for 1988-89 school year, effect definition of federal impact aid.

Following a call to order by the Chairman, Senator Langworthy moved that minutes of the Committee meeting of February 8 be approved. Senator Karr seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

The Chairman then announced that he had received a draft of a bill which had been requested by the Governor's office and which the Governor would like the Committee to introduce. The Chair explained that the bill related to the vocational education scholarship program and the division of duties of administration between the State Board of Education and the State Board of Regents. When the Chairman asked the Committee's pleasure, Senator Warren moved that the Committee introduce a bill as requested by the Governor. The motion was seconded by Senator Allen, and the motion carried.

The Chairman then told the Committee that Mr. Dale Dennis and his staff at the State Department of Education had prepared a computer printout as requested by the Committee yesterday. Mr. Dennis distributed copies of Computer Printout L8820 (Attachment 1), which, he explained, reflected figures for a proposed school finance plan based on a 1.75-year average adjusted valuation and taxable income. Mr. Dennis responded to Committee questions. He pointed out that the large urban districts did not benefit significantly in the figures shown on the new printout (L8820) and reminded the Committee that it must take into consideration the sales ratios, growth in valuation, and taxable income when interpreting the figures. He said that if any of these criteria should increase, this could have an adverse effect on the district. Mr. Dennis, replying to a question, said that the average estimated mill levy found in Col. 18 is around 55 mills and that only the districts with mill levy figures over 55 mills would benefit from the provisions contained in the new printout.

There was a feeling among Committee members that it will be important to compromise in order to resolve the problem of equitable funding to urban and rural school districts. One suggestion was to appoint a subcommittee to study a plan to help the urban districts without rural districts losing funds.

The Chairman told the Committee it was difficult to consider SB 525 without having a true picture of available funding and pointed out that this information will not be known until later in the session.

Mr. Dennis gave an amended figure of \$11.9million which, he explained, would be the approximate amount necessary to grandfather in all districts that stood to lose money according to the formula. Mr. Dennis noted an increase over last year in both taxable income and assessed valuation in Shawnee County but acknowledged that it could have been caused by annexation.

Members of the Committee expressed concern that adding more extra dollars to grandfather in some districts might result in a loss of additional funding for special education and transportation for all districts.

Senator Arasmith moved that SB 525 be recommended favorably for passage. Senator Montgomery seconded the motion.

Senator Parrish offered a substitute motion to amend SB 525 so as to allow districts an optional additional budget authority of one percent, subject to a protest petition. This one percent additional authority had been included in last year's school finance bill with a sunset after one year. Senator Karr seconded the substitute motion (see lines 0111 through 0134 in SB 525).

Senator Parrish then moved to amend her substitute motion by striking the wording on line 0121 so as to require publication of the resolution only once instead of three times in order to provide sufficient time for districts to complete the process of utilizing the protest petition option. Senator Allen seconded the motion.

With the consensus of the Committee, Senator Parrish modified her amendment to the substitute motion by making the bill effective upon publication in the Kansas Register to allow sufficient time before the boards' budgets must be adopted. Senator Allen seconded the motion, and the amendment was adopted.

When the Chair called for a vote on the original motion, as amended, the Chair ruled that the motion had carried. Senators Parrish, Anderson, and Salisbury requested that their nay votes be recorded.

The Chair adjourned the meeting.
