HCR 5061 - Suspending Joint Rule 5 concerning school district equalization bills

Following a call to order, the Chairman informed the Committee that he had called the meeting in order for the Committee to consider HCR 5061. He explained that the resolution would suspend Joint Rule 5 so as to allow for further consideration of the school finance bill, SB 525, concerning the School District Equalization Act.

The Chairman said he would like to see the resolution amended so that the deadline would not extend beyond the end of the day on Friday, April 8.
