ON ACT relating to insurance; concerning fees for examination of companies; amending K.S.A. 40-223 and repealing the existing section.

0020 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 40-223 is hereby amended to read as fol-0022 lows: 40-223. Any person who makes any examination under the 0023 provisions of this act, except as provided in K.S.A. 40-110 and 0024 40-253 and amendments thereto, may receive, as full compensa-0025 tion for such person's services, on a per diem basis an amount 0026 fixed by the commissioner, which shall not exceed the amount 0027 recommended by the national association of insurance commis-0028 sioners, for such time necessarily and actually occupied in going 0029 to and returning from the place of such examination and for such 0030 time the examiner is necessarily and actually engaged in making such examination including any day within the regular work-0032 week when the examiner would have been so engaged had the company or society been open for business, together with such necessary and actual expenses for traveling and subsistence as 0035 the examiner shall incur because of the performance of such 0036 services. For the purposes of this act, "necessary and actual expenses" shall be limited, whether for travel within the state or travel outside the state, to those limitations expressed in K.S.A. 75-3207 and amendments thereto which pertain to official travel outside the state. The daily charge shall be calculated by dividing the amount the examiner is authorized by the commissioner of insurance to charge per week by the number of days in the regular workweek of the company or society being examined. All of such compensation, expenses, the employer's share of 0045 the federal insurance contributions act taxes, the employer's

The amount paid for 0062 all outside consulting and data processing fees necessary to 0063 perform any examination, and the sum equal to the amount 0064 charged for annual leave to fund the purchase of examination 0065 equipment and computer software shall not collectively total 0066 more than \$25,000 at any one company examination including 0067 examination of its subsidiaries or combination thereof. Such 0068 demand shall be accompanied by the sworn statement of the 0069 person making such examination, setting forth in separate items 0070 the number of days necessarily and actually occupied in going to 0071 and returning from the place of such examination, the number of 0072 days the examiners were necessarily and actually engaged in 0073 making such examination including those days within the regu-0074 lar workweek while the examination was in progress and the 0075 company or society had closed for business, and the necessary 0076 and actual expenses for traveling and subsistence, incurred in 0077 and on account of such services. A duplicate of every such sworn 0078 statement shall be kept on file in the office of the commissioner 0079 of insurance. All moneys so paid to the commissioner of insur-0080 ance shall be remitted to the state treasurer and the state trea-0081 surer shall issue duplicate receipts therefor, one to be delivered 0082 to the commissioner of insurance and the other to be filed with
