The Chairman called the meeting to order and introduced Marvin Woodland who presented a list of proposed changes for  $\underline{SB}$  704 which concerns the examination and certification of electricians and electrical contractors. (Exhibit A)

The committee briefly discussed these proposals as well as those for  $\underline{SB}$  663 relating to plumbing and  $\underline{SB}$  705 concerning ventilation and air conditioning mechanics and contractors. Due to the time element and the complexity of these three bills the Chairman appointed a sub-committee consisting of Senator Vidricksen, Chairman, Senator Hoferer and Senator Strick to work out the details of this bill for the committee.

Attention was then turned to <u>SB 562</u> concerning the Kansas Civil Service Act. Art Griggs briefed the committee on the changes in this bill stating that at some points it goes to far, it does not take into consideration whether or not someone has held a particular job and in some areas there is not adequate justification for need. An amendment was submitted from Brad Avery, Legal Counsel for the Kansas Association of Public Employees (<u>Exhibit B</u>). Senator Francisco made a motion that the committee adopt this amendment. This was seconded by Senator Hoferer, and the motion carried.

A motion was then made by Senator Francisco to report SB 562 favorable for passage as amended. The motion was seconded by Senator Hoferer and carried.

Senate Bill 654 was presented for action. Senator Hoferer made a motion to recommend SB 654 favorable for passage as amended. (see balloon version in Exhibit C) Motion carried with Senator Francisco asking to be recorded as a "No" vote.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:30 p.m. by the Chairman.

- 1) In section 1, subsection "h" is hereby deleted.
- 2) In section 1, subsection "i" is hereby deleted.
- 3) In section 2: subsection(l) is amended to read as
  follows:

.....The classes and titles so specified and described shall be used for (a) original appointments, (b) promotions, (c) payrolls and (d) all other records affecting the status of persons in the classified service. but in no case shall any change in job class, title or function be used to require an employee in the classified service to assume significantly greater job duties without a commensurate change in salary.

0016 AN ACT relating to certain state officers and employees; con-0017 cerning personnel of the state board of indigents' defense 0018 services, the division of printing and the division of architec-0019 tural services; amending K.S.A. 75-1017, 75-1202a and 75-0020 1202d and K.S.A. 1987 Supp. 22-4524 and repealing the exist-0021 ing sections.

0022 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 75-1202a is hereby amended to read as 0024 follows: 75-1202a. (a) There is hereby established, within and as 0025 a part of the department of administration, a division of archi-0026 tectural services, the head of which shall be the director of 0027 architectural services. Under the supervision of the secretary of 0028 administration, the director of architectural services shall ad-0029 minister the division of architectural services. The director of 0030 architectural services shall be in the unclassified service under 0031 the Kansas civil service act and shall be appointed by the 0032 secretary of administration, with the advice of the state building 0033 advisory commission. Attorneys and space-management officers 0034 of the division of architectural services shall be in the unclas-0035 sified service under the Kansas civil service act. The director of 0036 architectural services may appoint an assistant director of ar-0037 chitectural services who shall be in the unclassified service 0038 under the Kansas civil service act.

(b) The director of architectural services shall have appro-0040 priate administrative and managerial experience and abilities 0041 commensurate with and necessary for the performance of the 0042 responsibilities of the office of director of architectural services. 0043 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 75-1202d is hereby amended to read as fol-0044 lows: 75-1202d. (a) The director of architectural services shall 0045 attend all meetings of the state building advisory commission and keep a full and correct record of its proceedings which when approved by the commission and signed by the chairperson shall be the official record. The director of architectural services shall have such powers and duties as may be prescribed or imposed by the secretary of administration or by law.

(b) Subject to approval by the secretary of administration and 0051 0052 in accordance with appropriation acts, the director of architec-0053 tural services shall appoint the professional, technical, adminis-0054 trative, clerical and other personnel of the division of architec-0055 tural services. Except as provided in K.S.A. 75-1202a and 75-2935 and amendments thereto, all professional and adminis-0057 trative positions of the division of architectural services shall be 0058 in the unclassified classified service under the Kansas civil 0059 service act. On and after the effective date of this act, all technienl, elerical and other nonprofessional positions of the division of 0061 architectural services shall be in the classified service under the 0062 Kansas civil service act. Each person performing services for the division of architectural services in any such nonprofessional position immediately prior to the effective date of this act shall continue in such position and shall attain permanent status in the elassified position without examination and without a proba-0067 tionary period. Such person shall retain all retirement benefits earned prior to the effective date of this act and such person's service shall be deemed to have been continuous. Each person employed on the day preceding the effective date of this act in a professional or administrative position in the division of archi-0072 tectural services, which is placed in the classified service under the Kansas civil service act by this act, shall continue in such position and shall attain permanent status in that classified position without examination and without a probationary 0076 period. Such person shall retain all retirement benefits earned prior to the effective date of this act and such person's service shall be deemed to have been continuous.

Sec. 3. K.S.A. 75-1017 is hereby amended to read as follows: 75-1017. The compensation to be paid employees of the division of printing shall be no greater than that paid by other printing and binding offices employing the same class of labor. (a) Except

as otherwise prescribed by law, all employees in the division of printing shall be in the classified service under the Kansas civil service act. Subject to, and in accordance with this section and K.S.A. 75-2938, and amendments thereto, on July 1, 1988, all positions in the division of printing in the classified service shall be assigned to job classes and pay ranges.

- (b) No employee who is employed in the division of printing ment of job positions and pay ranges pursuant to subsection (a) shall receive, as a result of such implementation, a rate of compensation for nonovertime work which, when equated to an hourly rate, is less than the hourly rate such employee was receiving for nonovertime work on June 30, 1988.
- 0096 (c) The standard workweek for classified employees of the 0097 division of printing shall be a 40-hour workweek, and such 0098 employees shall be assigned to a range on the pay plan based 0099 upon a 40-hour workweek. Payment of overtime pay to employ-0100 ees of the division of printing shall be in accordance with 0101 regulations adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 75-3747, and amend-0102 ments thereto.
- 0103 (d) Implementation of the provisions of this section shall not 0104 be deemed a violation of K.S.A. 75-4333, and amendments 0105 thereto.
- employees of the division of printing, unless biweekly payroll periods are established under K.S.A. 75-5501a, and amendments thereto, which apply to such officers and employees, the director of printing shall file a semimonthly payroll with the director of accounts and reports which shall cover a work period from the first to the fifteenth, and the sixteenth to the close of the month. If biweekly payroll periods are so established which apply to such officers and employees, the director of printing shall file biweekly payrolls with the director of accounts and reports therefor. The compensation for semimonthly payrolls shall be paid to the officers and employees semimonthly on the fifth day following the end of the preceding semimonthly work period, and the biweekly earnings shall be paid to officers and employ-

0120 ees on the twelfth calendar day following the end of the 0121 biweekly work period.

Sec. 4. K.S.A. 1987 Supp. 22-4524 is hereby amended to read as follows: 22-4524. (a) There is hereby created the position of the state director of indigents' defense services. The director shall be in the unclassified service under the Kansas civil service act, the shall be appointed by the state board of indigents' defense services and shall devote full time to the performance of the duties of the office of director.

(b) The state director of indigents' defense services, the oiso assistant director and all other officers and employees attorneys appointed or employed by the state board of indigents' defense services shall be in the unclassified service under the Kansas civil service act. All other officers and employees of the board oiso shall be in the classified service.

0135 Sec. 5. K.S.A. 75-1017, 75-1202a and 75-1202d and K.S.A.0136 1987 Supp. 22-4524 are hereby repealed.

O137 Sec. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and O138 after its publication in the statute book.

(c) Each person employed on the day preceding the effective date of this act who is an officer or employee of the board, which is placed in the classified service under the Kansas civil service act by this act, shall continue in such position and shall attain permanent status in that classified position without examination and without a probationary period. Such person shall retain all retirement benefits earned prior to the effective date of this act and such person's service shall be deemed to have been continuous.
