Committee discussion was held on $\underline{\text{House Bill 2287}}$ concerning an amendment that will be offered on the Senate floor to remove the word recklessly. There was little objection on the part of committee members to the floor amendment.

House Bill 2260 - Mandatory sentence for crimes with firearms, exceptions.

presumption on first time offenses. Senator Winter seconded

the motion. No further action will be taken on the bill until

staff brings language back on the amendment for committee consideration.
