The Vice-Chairman, Senator Werts, called the meeting to order.

HB 2720 - Appropriations for FY 1989, state board of education agencies, state library and public broadcasting commission.

Senator Doyen reviewed the Senate Subcommittee Report on $\frac{HB}{2720}$ and HB 2796, the FY 1988 Supplemental Appropriations bill.

In regard to the Department of Education, FY 1989, Senate Subcommittee recommendation number six, Senator Talkington stated that he felt it was too soon to decide on the amount to be appropriated to general aid to school districts and it should be reviewed at the end of the session when there would be a better knowledge of the total revenues available. Senator Talkington made the motion to delete Senate Subcommittee Recommendation number six under the Department of Education for FY 1989. Senator Kerr seconded the motion. Following discussion, the motion failed on a show of hands.

Senator Feleciano offered a motion to change the proviso to the bilingual education programs aid from three years to five year in line 0204. Senator Gannon seconded the motion and following discussion, the motion failed on a show of hands.

Senator Bogina moved, Senator Doyen seconded, to have the Senate Subcommittee Report on HB 2720 reflect concern that there has not been enough attention paid to, and development of, bilingual education programs and note that it is the responsibility of the local school districts to give this issue more attention. The motion carried on a voice vote.

There was discussion concerning recommendations made under the Kansas Public Broadcasting Commission.

Senator Gaines moved, Senator Doyen seconded, to adopt the Senate Subcommittee Report on HB 2720 and HB 2796. The motion carried on a voice vote.

Senator Gaines moved, Senator Doyen seconded, to report HB 2720 favorably, as amended, for passage. The motion carried on a roll call vote.

The meeting was adjourned.
