Senator Salisbury moved, Senator Rock seconded, the introduction of bill draft 9 RS 0985, an act making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal years ending June 30, 1989, and June 30, 1990, for Fort Hays state university, Kansas state university, Kansas state university veterinary medical center, Emporia state university, Pittsburg state university, university of Kansas, university of Kansas medical center, Wichita state university, Kansas college of technology, state board of regents and department of education; authorizing certain transfers, imposing certain restrictions and limitations, and directing or authorizing certain receipts and disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing. The motion carried.

SB 68 - Appropriations for FY 1990, state library, school for the visually handicapped, school for the deaf, historical society, council on vocational education, commission on bicentennial of U.S. constitution and public broadcasting commission.

Senator Doyen reviewed the Subcommittee Report for FY 1989 and FY 1990 regarding the State Library. Senator Harder reviewed the Subcommittee Report for FY 1989 and FY 1990 concerning the Kansas Arts Commission. There was discussion regarding available Economic Development Incentives Fund (EDIF) dollars for Kansas Arts Commission programs. Senator Allen moved, Senator Harder seconded, to request the House Appropriations subcommittee review the recommendation of Kansas, Inc. and the contractual responsibilities of Kansas Arts Commission along with the availability of EDIF monies to fund ongoing commitments. The motion carried.

Senator Gaines moved, Senator Salisbury seconded, to add \$350,000, from the EDIF for the Kansas Arts Commission Programming Grants in FY 1990. Following discussion, the motion carried.

Senator Kerr reviewed the Subcommittee Reports for FY 1989 and FY 1990 regarding the School for the Visually Handicapped and the School for the Deaf. Senator Kerr moved, Senator Rock seconded, to recommend as a supplemental request item number four, page two, Kansas School for the Visually Handicapped, which requests \$2,750 from the State General Fund to replace a stove which is beyond repair. The motion carried.

Senator Winter reviewed the Subcommittee Report for FY 1989 and FY 1990 concerning the Historical Society. Senator Doyen reviewed the Subcommittee Report for FY 1989 and FY 1990 concerning the State Council on Vocational Education. Senator Harder reviewed the Subcommittee Report for FY 1989 and FY 1990 regarding the Bicentennial Commission. Senator Winter moved, Senator Gaines seconded, the addition of \$42,750 in FY 1990 for the Bicentennial Commission from the State General Fund. On a show of hand of four voting for the motion and five voting against the motion, the motion failed.
