## Proposed Amendment to Senate Bill No. 505

On page 1, in line 15, after "74-503.", by inserting "(a)";
On page 3, following line 5, by inserting a new subsection
and a new section as follows:

"(b) The provisions of the Kansas sunset law apply to the state board of agriculture and to the office of secretary of the state board of agriculture provided for by this section, and the state board and office of the secretary of the state board are subject to abolition under that law.

"New Sec. 2. Except as provided in K.S.A. 74-7246, and amendments thereto, the state board of agriculture and the office of secretary of the state board of agriculture, provided for by K.S.A. 74-503, and amendments thereto, shall be and hereby are abolished on July 1, 1991.";

By renumbering sections 2 and 3 as sections 3 and 4, respectively;

In the title, in line 10, after the semicolon, by inserting "subjecting the state board and office of the secretary of the state board to the provisions of the Kansas sunset law;"
