Chairman Hensley entertained a motion to approve the minutes of the March 5, 6, 7 and 8, 1991 meetings. Rep. Darlene Cornfield moved, seconded by Rep. Darrel Webb, that the minutes of the March 5, 6, 7 and 8 meetings be approved. Motion carried.

The chairman announced further discussion on <u>Senate Bill No. 270</u>. He reminded the members that at the end of yesterday's meeting Rep. Sam Roper had proposed to amend the bill. The chairman recognized Rep. Roper.

Rep. Roper moved to amend Senate Bill No. 270 by adding a new section making it unlawful to refuse to hire or discharge any individual because the individual engages in lawful activities off the employer's premises during nonworking hours. Rep. Theo Cribbs seconded the motion. Motion carried by a vote of 10 to 9.

Rep. Webb moved to report House Substitute for Senate Bill No. 270 favorable for passage. Rep. Cribbs seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The chairman announced discussion and final action on House Bill 2401.

Rep. Susan Wagle moved to amend House Bill No. 2401 on page 4, subsection (h), to delete any reference to competitive bidding and to insert in lieu thereof a new provision establishing "negotiated bidding" procedures. Rep. Diane Gjerstad seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Rep. Cornfield moved to report House Bill No. 2401 favorable for passage, as amended. Rep. Gene Amos seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The chairman announced discussion and final action on House Bill No. 2554.

Rep. Roper moved to amend House Bill No. 2554 on page 1, line 28, by inserting, "and of the administrative unit, in which the employee is employed, which was..."

Rep. George Gomez seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Rep. Diane Gjerstad moved to report House Bill No. 2554 favorable for passage, as amended. Rep. Roper seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Chairman Hensley announced discussion and final action on House Bill No. 2196.

Rep. Tim Carmody moved to table House Bill No. 2196. Rep. Al Lane seconded the motion. Motion failed by a vote of 8 to 9.

Rep. Gjerstad moved to report House Bill No. 2196 favorable for passage. The motion was seconded by Rep. Cornfield. Motion carried.

The chairman announced that the committee would discuss and take final action next week on <u>House Bill No. 2076</u>. He also announced that the committee would conduct a hearing on <u>House Bill No. 2620</u>, relating to workers' compensation insurance.
