Dear Senator Burke:

During committee deliberations this session, the Senate Ways and Means Committee agreed to request interim studies on several subjects. The Committee requests that the Legislative Coordinating Council designate special committees to study each of the following proposals:

- 1) Review of statutory duties of the State Fire Marshal and other public safety agencies in view of eliminating obsolete provisions and evaluating liability issues in connection with the functions of such agencies
- 2) Continued validity of the annual demand transfer from the state general fund to the Workers' Compensation Fund
- 3) Overcrowding of the state's youth centers and alternatives for dealing with juvenile offenders (HB 2630)
- 4) Provide legislative oversight of the Department of Administration's Central Management Systems, specifically the Kansas Financial Information System (KFIS) project. (The Chairman requests that this proposal be assigned to the Budget Committee for review)
- 5) Various management issues relating to the state court system
- 6) Study organization, structure, powers and duties of the public broadcasting commission and the method by which

Kansas public television and radio stations receive state funding. A proviso was placed on the grant to KHCC-FM (Hutchinson Public Radio Station) during the 1991 session for the expansion of a public radio signal to require that an interim legislative committee establish whether the area to be covered is truly underserved.

It is further requested that the special committees make reports and recommendations to the 1992 session of the Legislature.
