<u>Hearing on SB 512</u> - An act concerning group life insurance for school districts and community colleges

Mr. Chris Courtwright of the Research Department gave a staff review of the bill. This bill would amend KSA 72-8415a and 72-8415b, two statutes concerning the authority of the board of education of any school district or the board of trustees of any community college to act as a self-insurer for certain types of insurance. The bill would allow those entities to self-insure for group life benefits in addition to health care services and disability income benefits.

Ms. Robin Nichols, representing the Wichita Public Schools, spoke as a proponent of the bill. The bill corrects an oversight in a 1990 enactment which sought to secure authority to self-fund for group life insurance benefits for eligible employees. Following enactment of that bill (HB 3068), the district learned from its attorney that a self-funded program could not be implemented unless authorized by both the statutes being amended by this bill. (See Attachment 1).

Representative Cornfield moved that the bill be passed out favorably and placed on the consent calendar. Representative Wells seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Representative Welshimer moved to accept the minutes of the March 30 meeting. Representative Wells seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Testimony Before the House Insurance Committee In Support of Senate Bill 512 By Robin Nichols, Wichita Public Schools March 31, 1992

Mr. Chairman, Members of the Committee:

My name is Robin Nichols. I thank you for the opportunity to come before you today to request your support for Senate Bill 512.

In 1990, boards of education of school districts and community colleges were authorized to act as selfinsurers for certain types of insurance including health care services and disability income benefits.

An oversight in the 1990 enactment did not allow us to self-insure for group life benefits. SB 512 would amend KŠA 72-8415(a), and (b) to do so. Our attorneys advised us to request correction of this oversight, which brings me here today. I thank you for your attention and ask for your support.
