

MINUTES OF THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON FEDERAL AND STATE AFFAIRS.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Clyde Graeber at 1:30 p.m. on March 23, 1993 in Room 526-S of the Capitol.

The Chairperson stated that final action would be looked at today on HB 2262, HB 2513, and SB 382.

The Chairperson stated that on March 18 the committee voted to accept the sub-committee's draft as a substitute HB 2262 and asked the committee if they wished to take any action.

Representative Lahti moved and Representative Lane seconded to table HB 2262 and study over the summer. The motion carried.

The Chairperson stated that HB 2513, which sets aside 2% of the purse for a benevolent fund was heard on March 11, 1993, and all parties were not in agreement. The Chairperson then asked if the committee wanted to take any action.

Representative Empson stated at the end of the meeting we were told by a representative of the Thoroughbred Association they wanted to hold this bill over and give the Thoroughbred Association time to work with the Quarterhorse Association and work out any disagreements, and apparently since that time he has been led to believe that this bill could be passed out of here as it is now and that really angers me. I think if we pass this bill now we will be stopping any type of agreement between the Thoroughbred and Quarterhorse Association.

Representative Empson moved and Representative Cornfield seconded to table HB 2513. The motion carried.

The Chairperson stated that the Attorney General's Office has requested SB 382, an act amending the charitable organizations and solicitations act and we held a hearing on March 18. The Chairperson asked the committee what action they wished to take on SB 382.

Representative Lane moved and Representative Kline seconded to move SB 382 out of committee favorably. The motion carried.

The Chairperson stated this was the last regular meeting of the committee, there could possibly be a meeting called next week and if so it will be in the morning.

The meeting adjourned at 2:15 P.M.
