MINUTES OF THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS AND INSURANCE.

**Action on SB 306: Life and health guaranty fund limits**

Representative Cox moved that the bill be passed favorably out of committee. The motion was seconded by Representative Correll. The motion carried.

**Action on SB 187: Reimbursement for services of advanced registered nurse practioners**

An amendment to the bill was added by the Senate which would establish 1998 as an expiration date for this legislation. At that time the practice would be reviewed to see if additional costs have occurred or if there was a need for such services as provided by the ARNP's.

Representative Helgerson moved that the bill be passed. The motion was seconded by Representative Weiland. Representative Neufeld offered a substitute motion to table the bill and recommend it for study by an interim committee. Representative King seconded the motion. The substitute motion failed. A vote on the original motion by Representative Helgerson to pass the bill favorably was announced. The motion carried.

**Action on SB 36: Loan production offices of banks**

Representative King moved to reconsider the bill due to technical problems in several of the sections. Representative Neufeld seconded the motion. The way the bill is written now might cause undue hardships on bank branches and could possibly strip the operation of production loan offices. The motion carried. Representative King moved to withdraw the original motion to pass SB 36 favorably. Representative Weiland declined to withdraw his second. Representative Phil Kline made a substitute motion to table the bill. The motion was seconded by Representative Gilbert. The motion carried. Chairman Bryant announced that no further action would be taken on the bill this year.

Representative Allen moved for the approval of the minutes of March 17 and 22. Representative Watson seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The final meeting of the year adjourned at 4:00 p.m.
