A "balloon" to HB 2038 was presented to the committee by a request from Senator Bond. This amendment would delete section (a) (4) and read "received in excess of 10% of the combined taxable income of the individual and such individual's spouse in any year as compensation from a governmental agency unit or a governmental subdivision or from the sale of goods or services to the state of Kansas or any agency thereof; or (5)". The amendment would also change the wording in section (b) (5) by deleting "hold a substantial interest in or" and adding after thereof "receive in excess of 10% of the combined taxable income of the individual and such individual's spouse in any year as compensation from a governmental agency unit or a governmental subdivision or from the sale of goods or services to the state of Kansas or any agency thereof". Carol Williams, Kansas Commission on Governmental Standards and Conduct, offered an amendment to the committee which would delete the substantial interest wording and add "had a substantial interest in or been an officer of any vendor of goods or services to the state of Kansas or any agency thereof where the value of the contract with the state or any agency exceeded \$_____ in any calendar year;". After much discussion, HB 2038 will be continued on Tuesday, February 16.
