(1) Conflict reconciliation bill that reconciles the conflicts created during the 1992 legislative session between the Sentencing Guidelines Act and the criminal code revisions enacted as proposed by the Judicial Council, both effective July 1, 1993.

(2) Conflict reconciliation bill that reconciles conflicts created during the 1992 legislative session relating to criminal law other than the ones contained in the previous request.

(3) A bill creating a statewide public defender system for juveniles.

AN ACT concerning civil procedure; relating to adverse possession; amending K.S.A. 60-503 and repealing the existing section.

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 60-503 is hereby amended to read as follows: 60-503. No-action-shall-be-maintained-against Any person for-the-recovery-of-real-property who has been in open, exclusive and continuous possession of such real property, either under a claim knowingly adverse or under a belief of ownership, for a period of fifteen-(15) 15 years shall notify the owner of record 12 months prior to claiming ownership of such property. This section-shall-not-apply-to-any-action-commenced-within-one--(1) year-after-the-effective-date-of-this-act.

- Sec. 2. K.S.A. 60-503 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
