Staff briefed the Committee on **HB 2546** - Health assessments of school pupils.

The bill delays the effective date of the mandate contained in K.S.A. 72-5214 that requires currently that on and after July 1, 1993, any pupil entering a Kansas school for the first time present the results of a health assessment recorded on a form provided by the Secretary of Health and Environment to the appropriate school board. As amended by **HB 2546**, the date on which the health assessments would be required would be on or after July 1, 1994 - a delay of one year. Senator Ramirez made a motion **HB 2546** be recommended favorably for passage, seconded by Senator Langworthy. The motion carried.
