Staff briefed the Committee on HB 2546 - Health assessments of school pupils.

The bill delays the effective date of the mandate contained in K.S.A. 72-5214 that requires currently that on and after July 1, 1993, any pupil entering a Kansas school for the first time present the results of a health assessment recorded on a form provided by the Secretary of Health and Environment to the appropriate school board. As amended by HB 2546, the date on which the health assessments would be required would be on or after July 1, 1994 - a delay of one year. Senator Ramirez made a motion HB 2546 be recommended favorably for passage, seconded by Senator Langworthy. The motion carried.
