The chairman introduced Col. Lonnie McCollum who appeared before the committee for confirmation of his appointment as Superintendent of the Kansas Highway Patrol. (See Confirmation Questionnaire - Attachment A and Statement of Substantial Interest - Attachment B) Col. McCollum presented information on his background and experience in law enforcement and stated that he believed in base line service. He strongly supports his staff, runs his office efficiently and stresses quality work. He stood for questions from the committee.

The chairman then asked the committee to consider **SB 1**. There was some discussion and Senator Brady made a motion for a substitute bill which would increase the fees \$10 for the first year and \$10 for the second year for a total of \$20. After that time the bill would revert back to its present form. This was seconded by Senator Burke. Motion carried.

A motion was then made by Senator Harris to allow the absence of a helmet to be used in litigation. This was seconded by Senator Emert. Motion carried.

Senator Burke made a motion to recommend Col. Lonnie McCollum for confirmation by the Senate. This was seconded by Senator Harris. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Senator Jones to approve the minutes of the February 10th and February 16th meeting. This was seconded by Senator Tiahrt. Motion carried.

Senator Brady made a motion to introduce the substitute bill for **SB 1**. A second was made by Senator Harris and the motion carried.

The meeting was then adjourned by the chairman.



This correspondence is presented as documentation of our conversation earlier in September regarding my receipt of consulting fees from a drug and alcohol testing corporation.

The Corporation, U. S. Alcohol Testing of America, (USAT), is involved in the sale of a small amount of repair parts and testing supplies to support equipment sold to Kansas in 1987. At that time, the company that actually sold equipment was not USAT but was purchased by them about two years later. They are now the exclusive manufacturer of the type of equipment we use. Repair parts and consumables we currently purchase from USAT would probably be less than five hundred (\$500.00) per year.

In August of this year, I advised and worked with them on several technical aspects of alcohol testing equipment. This service was consistent with a corporation, DARTT, which I had formed, designed to service the private sector with drug and alcohol testing in the drug free work place arena.

The only piece of this equipment that would likely be offered for use by Kansas law enforcement personnel would be a portable drug testing apparatus utilized by non-technical personnel. That possibility, in my estimation, remains several years in the future.

For my services, I received four thousand dollars (\$4,000). The last check for one thousand dollars (\$1,000) was received October 17, 1992, paid to my corporation, DARTT.
