Chairman Crowell opened the hearing on HB 2554 regarding duplicate or substitute drivers' licenses. Bruce Kinzie referenced the bill and offered information as to why the bill was requested.

The Chairman recognized Betty McBride who also provided background information to the Committee. The question arose when a Kansas resident asked the Division of Vehicles for a duplicate copy of his driver's license. The Division refused the duplication because only one driver's license can be attained, legally, in Kansas. The constituent asked that the statute be changed to reflect the "real" meaning in which a substitute driver's license can be issued if the original is lost, stolen or damaged.

Chairman Crowell closed the hearing on HB 2554.
