Chairman Crowell called the Committee's attention to <u>SB 799</u> regarding alternative fuels. <u>Rep. King made a motion to favorably recommend SB 799 for passage. It was seconded by Rep. Shore.</u>

Rep. Pauls made a conceptual substitute motion regarding the appropriate statutory cite to the Energy Act. It was seconded by Rep. McKinney. The motion passed.

Rep. Shore made a motion to favorably recommend SB 799 as amended for passage. It was seconded by Rep. King. Rep. Garner made a substitute motion to re-insert the requirement for fleets of the State of Kansas to have a certain percent of alternative fuel vehicles. It was seconded by Rep. Correll. Discussion by the Committee took place. The substitute motion failed on a voice vote. The original motion by Rep. Shore carried.

The Chairman brought the Committee's attention to <u>HB 3070</u> regarding the funding for the transportation needs of the elderly and disabled. <u>Rep. Smith made a motion for the Committee to favorably pass HB 3070.</u> <u>It was seconded by Rep. Webb.</u>

Rep. Pauls made a substitute motion changing the word handicapped to disabled where it occurs in the Act. It was seconded by Rep. McClure. The motion passed. Rep. Pauls made a motion to recommend favorable passage of HB 3070 as amended. Rep. Smith seconded the motion.

Rep. Dillon made a substitute motion to amend \$600,000 to \$1,000,000. Rep. Correll seconded the motion. A division was called for and the motion passed with 13 voting in favor.

Rep. Dillon made a motion to recommend favorably for passage, HB 3070 as further amended. It was seconded by Rep. Correll. The motion carried.
