Meeting of the Senate Commerce subcommittee on SB 591-Limited deregulation of the telecommunication industry.

The Committee met to discuss part III of the legislative proposal for SB 591.

It was the consensus of the subcommittee a bill be drafted to extend TeleKansas I to March 1997 and prohibit the KCC from reviewing Southwestern Bell's earnings prior to 1996. The subcommittee also requested a resolution requesting the KCC and Southwestern Bell to negotiate an agreement on an appropriate incremental investment over cost of services over the two years of the extension of TeleKansas I.
