Senators Ranson and Brady requested they be recorded as voting "no" on SB 472.

Hearings were continued on SB 489-relating to elections (NVRA).

Brad Bryant, Office of the Secretary of State, continued his testimony from yesterday at section 13 of his outline.

Mr. Bryant suggested an amendment on page 14, subsection (d) under Section 14, line 10, which would add five words to the beginning of the sentence, "The voter registration portion of". He informed the committee that the Secretary of State's Office and the Division of Motor Vehicles agreed on this amendment.

Chairperson Lawrence announced that hearings will continue tomorrow on SB 489.

The meeting adjourned at 2:20 p.m.
