MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON FEDERAL AND STATE AFFAIRS

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Lana Oleen at 12:15 p.m. on April 28, 1994, in Room 254-E of the Capitol.

All members were present except:

Sens. Parkinson and Walker were excused

Sen. Oleen referred to <u>HB 3082</u>, relating to funding for local drug and gang resistance programs. Sen. Oleen suggested the bill could be referred to the Joint Committee on Children and Families in order to consider it along with related issues. <u>Sen. Jones made a motion HB 3082 be referred to the Joint Committee on Children and Families, and it was seconded by Sen. Tillotson; the motion passed.</u>

Sen. Oleen referred to <u>HB 3097</u>, relating to racing and parimutuel wagering, which is on general orders in the Senate, and to the controversy between the Quarterhorse Association and the Thoroughbred Association relating to division of the simulcast funds. She called attention to <u>HB 2836</u>, amending the parimutuel racing act, and the amendment passed by this committee relating to the division of the funds. However, based on language in the Committee report, there is a question if the intent of the committee is expressed correctly. Sen. Oleen stated she has requested staff clarify the language question and to check with the Racing Commission and the Executive Director of the Commission. She stated she has requested <u>HB 3097</u> be held until this issue can be resolved.

Sen. Oleen opened the confirmation hearing for Larry Von Feldt, who has been appointed to the Lottery Commission. She introduced Mr. Von Feldt, who referred to the Senate Confirmation Questionnaire (Attachment 1) and gave background information (Attachment 2) to the committee. Sen. Vidricksen questioned Mr. Von Feldt regarding question No. 5, relating to registered lobbyists, on the Confirmation Questionnaire and stated Mr. Von Feldt answered he has not been a lobbyist. However, because of his involvement with the Association of Realtors, he was responsible for employing a lobbyist to represent them. Mr. Von Feldt agreed with Sen. Vidricksen and apologized and agreed to correct his statement. Sen. Oleen asked Mr. Von Feldt how he was appointed to the Commission. Mr. Von Feldt stated he was acquainted with Paul Steele, who was the first chairman for the Lottery, and told him he would like to contribute and serve on the Commission. Recently, he was told there was a vacancy on the Commission, and he asked if he could be considered for appointment to the Lottery Commission. Sen. Oleen then stated the Kansas law contains a repealer which is up for renewal next year and will require action during the next Legislative session. She stated she assumes Mr. Von Feldt is a supporter of the Lottery and would work toward renewing the legislation for the Lottery. Mr. Von Feldt stated he has been a long-time supporter of the Lottery, and he will assist in any way he can to renew the Lottery. Sen. Oleen stated the Questionnaire indicated KBI checks have been completed on Mr. Von Feldt, and he answered they have been; that he had to answer many questions for the KBI.

Sen. Oleen closed the confirmation hearing and announced the committee will take action soon, since we are in the Veto session. Sen. Vidricksen encouraged Mr. Von Feldt to make the correction on question No. 5 of the Questionnaire, as was discussed.

Sen. Oleen called the committees' attention to Minutes for March 22, 23, 24 and April 1 and 7. <u>Sen. Vidricksen made a motion the Minutes be approved, and the motion was seconded by Sen. Jones; the motion passed.</u>

Sen. Oleen stated the committee will meet at the Rail sometime during the remainder of the Veto session to take action on the confirmation of Mr. Von Feldt and other issues requiring action before adjournment.

Meeting adjourned at 12:30.
