MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY.

SB 762--liability of officers and directors of certain financial institutions

A motion was made by Senator Emert, seconded by Senator Ranson to report SB 762 favorably. The motion carried.

Senator Vancrum asked to be recorded as abstaining on SB 762.

SB 807--family violence prevention programs

Senator Bond gave a Family Law Subcommittee report on SB 807 and a description of suggested amendments.

A motion was made by Senator Martin, seconded by Senator Bond to adopt the subcommittee report on SB 807. The subcommittee report provided:

- 1) increase in the docket fee from district court, municipal court and county code and resolution enforcement courts on non-civil cases.
- 2) the resulting monies to be placed in a protection from abuse fund.
- 3) the fund is to be distributed on a grant basis to be used for domestic violence centers and child abuse and neglect assistance programs.
- 4) the court costs are to be collected state wide and the board of county commissioners shall have authority to administer the grant program.

The motion carried.

A motion was made by Senator Bond, seconded by Senator Oleen to report SB 807 favorably as amended. The motion carried.

SB 648--licensure to carry certain concealed weapons

A motion was made by Senator Martin, seconded by Senator Harris to adopt the balloon by Senator Tiahrt on SB 648 and report SB 648 favorably as amended.

A substitute motion was made by Senator Brady, seconded by Senator Rock to table SB 648. The motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 5:30 p.m.
