Subject: Transportation Subcommittee

The Senate Transportation Subcommittee on Salvage Yards met in 522S on Tuesday, February 3, 1994. Present were Senator Papay, Senator Tiahrt, and Senator Jones.

SB 162 was explained and the changes made by the committee previously were highlighted by Bruce Kinzie.

The main point of contention is section 4 (w)(2)(B) which states: "No person licensed as a salvage vehicle pool under this act shall: sell a salvage vehicle to any person except a person licensed as a salvage vehicle dealer under this act unless sales tax is collected, unless otherwise exempted from sales tax by law;"

It was the consensus of the subcommittee to send SB 162 with the changes back to the full Transportation Committee.
