The meeting was called for the purpose of discussion and possible action on <u>SB 260</u> - Repealing the statute dealing with the national checkoff for sheep and wool products. After discussion was held, motion was made by Representative Tim Shallenburger that HB 2576 - An act concerning animals; prohibiting the importation or possession of feral swine; relating to the definition of garbage that is fed to animals; amending K.S.A. 47-1301 and repealing the existing section, in its original form be attached to SB 260. Motion was seconded by Representative Ed McKechnie and was passed unanimously. Motion was then made by Representative Shallenburger that SB 260 with amendment (HB 2576) be passed and sent to the House for debate; motion seconded by Representative McKechnie and duly passed.

Motion was then made by Representative Ed McKechnie that a proposed bill (5 RS 1291) which is an act concerning crimes and punishment; relating to criminal defamation; amending K.S.A. 1994 Supp. 21-4004 and repealing the existing section be introduced. Motion was seconded by Representative Tom Sawyer and, after discussion, the motion passed unanimously.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, the meeting adjourned at 12:45 p.m.
