MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURE.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson David Corbin at 10:00 a.m. on March 15, 1995 in Room 423-S of the Capitol.

A motion was made by Senator Tillotson to adopt the minutes of March 13. The motion was seconded by Senator Sallee. The motion carried.

Chairperson Corbin opened the hearing on <u>SB 310</u> - relating to animal remedies; creating the animal fee fund; authorizing the livestock commissioner to issue certificates of health; licensing video auctions. Staff reviewed the bill.

George Teagarden said their budget was taken care of through FY 96, by using funds from other fee funds, but those fee funds would be depleted at the end of FY 96. They would be \$100 thousand short for FY 97 unless they received funds from the general fund or they were able to increase fee funds. At the present time the producers fee funds are protecting consumers and fulfilling the statutory requirements of the animal disease control department. A schedule of fee charges was distributed (Attachment 1).

Responding to a question concerning who was on the special task force, Mike Beam said it did not include representatives from the pharmaceutical companies.

A lengthy discussion followed concerning what would be the best approach for funding the Animal Disease Control Department. Chairperson Corbin appointed a subcommittee to review the fee proposals and submit a recommendation to the Committee on March 17. Members appointed to the subcommittee were: Senators: Corbin, Clark, Downey and Tillotson.

The meeting adjourned at 11:00 a.m.

The next meeting is scheduled for March 16, 1995.
