SB 17 would require the Adjutant General's Department to provide, free of charge, copies of an individual's military service record if the request includes proof of correspondence from the United States Veterans Administration or the Kansas Commission on Veterans' Affairs that the individual is attempting to obtain benefits from the United States Veterans Administration.

SB 17, as introduced, would have no fiscal impact on the operations of the Adjutant General.
