Sen. Oleen asked the committee to direct its attention to <u>SB 363</u>, an act authorizing the placement of a sculpture on the statehouse grounds. <u>Sen. Vidricksen made a motion to amend the bill to read that no public moneys shall be expended for the purpose of financing the creation, construction or maintenance of the sculpture or its pedestal. <u>Sen. Walker seconded the motion; the motion passed</u>. <u>Sen. Vidricksen made a motion to recommend the bill as amended for favorable action and the motion was seconded by Sen. Walker. The motion passed</u>.</u>

Sen. Oleen directed the committee attention to <u>SCR 1606</u>, a concurrent resolution providing for the convening of a conference of the states. <u>Sen. Praeger made a motion to amend the bill to add clarifying language which states that the resolution shall not be constructed to be an application to Congress by the <u>Legislature of the State of Kansas to convene a constitutional convention under Article 5 of the Constitution of the United States and the conference of the states shall not be convened as such a constitutional convention. The motion was seconded by Sen. Papay; the motion passed.</u></u>

Sen. Vidricksen made a motion to amend the bill to strike, on page 2, line 1, the word "may" and insert the word "shall". The motion was seconded by Sen. Walker; the motion passed.

Sen. Jones made a motion the committee pass SCR 1606 as amended favorably and the motion was seconded by Sen. Papay. The motion passed.

Sen. Oleen called for further discussion, and seeing none, the meeting was adjourned at 3:55 p.m.
