A motion was made by Senator Sallee to adopt the minutes of February 15 as corrected, and the minutes of February 16 and February 19. Senator Clark seconded the motion. Motion carried.

SB 704 - concerning the quality and quantity of petroleum products, and SB 705 - concerning weights and measures devices.

Chairperson Corbin announced a balloon of both bills had been distributed. He asked if there was any discussion on the balloons. Senator Steffes moved to adopt the amendments to SB 704 and SB 705 and new bills be drafted to be designated as Substitute for SB 704 and Substitute for SB 705. Senator Clark seconded the motion. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Senator Clark that Substitute for SB 704 be passed and Substitute for SB 705 be passed. Senator Downey seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Chairperson Corbin asked the Committee what their pleasure was on <u>SB 558 - licensing wildlife such</u> as tigers, wolves and bears. Discussion followed. The consensus of the Committee was to allow this issue to be handled at the local level at this time. The meeting adjourned at 10:35.
