Senator Langworthy asked the conference committee composed of Senator Hardenburger, Chairman, Senator Ranson and Senator Martin to report on HB 2114.

The conference committee recommended HB 2114 be gutted and to insert HB 2999. Senator Ranson explained the changes in the bill and she said it would clarify what the retailer has to do. She explained what is changed from current law. It particularly defines the "burden of proof" and "good faith".

Senator Martin made a motion to gut HB 2114 and to insert HB 2999, as amended, and pass the bill favorably. Senator Hardenburger seconded the motion. The motion passed.
