MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON FEDERAL AND STATE AFFAIRS.

The meeting was called to order by Senator Carolyn Tillotson at 11:15 a.m. on February 7, 1996 in Room 254-E of the Capitol.

Senator Tillotson introduced Cindy Lash, a member of the Legislative Post Audit staff who reviewed the Performance Audit Report relative to the Regulatory Activities of the Kansas Racing Commission. Following her review of the report, Senator Tillotson requested questions from the committee.

Senator Jones stated that a question came up during the interim last year as to whether the position of Director of Racing was necessary . Terry Hamblin, attorney for the Racing Commission responded that it was a very needed position but that the requirement of 10-years' experience coupled with a salary of \$40,000 had eliminated any applicants for the position. The Commission will be requesting legislation that will resolve the problem. Another open position is that of Inspector of Paramutuels and that position may only be filled by the Executive Director of the racing commission and applications have now been received and interviews are being conducted for the job. The question was also raised as to why there had been so many Executive Directors, five in seven years, with the response being that there had been a difference in philosophy with the commission and now that the position is being filled by Gubernatorial appointment, that situation should be rectified.

Senator Oleen announced that the Linton Report would be covered on Thursday, February 8 and the current Racing Commission would be responding to it. Senator Oleen also said that she had met with the Department of Administration with regard to SB 474, the Whistleblower Act and that the committee would continue their discussion of the bill on Thursday.

Senator Ramirez made a motion that the committee introduce a consitutional amendment and enabling legislation should the amendment be passed by the voters of Kansas which would cover electronic games of chance. Senator Jones seconded the motion. Senator Hensley requested clarification as to whether the motion also covered the enabling legislation for such a bill and whether hearings would be held on the bill when it was introduced. Senator Oleen stated that anytime legislation comes to the committee, anyone may request a hearing and it would be held. <u>Senator Ramirez stated that his motion included the enabling legislation tied to the constitutional amendment and Senator Jones concurred with the second. The motion</u> carried.

Senator Praeger made a motion that the minutes for January 30 and 31 be approved as printed and Senator Tillotson seconded the motion. The motion carried.

There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 12:00 p.m.
