MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATION.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Al Ramirez at 1:30 p.m. on March 11, 1996 in Room 531--N of the Capitol.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ramirez at 1:30 p.m.
The minutes of the February 27 meeting were approved on a motion by Senator Steffes, with a second by Senator Papay.

SB 563-concerning the state certified and licensed real property appraisers act.

Fred Carman, Revisor, submitted an amendment that was agreed to by the Appraisal Board and the Attorney General's office. The amendment also met with approval by those committee members that had concerns with the bill prior to the amendment.

On page 3, line 10, after the letters 'tive,' deleting the words 'without prior notice' and adding the words "upon prior notice which shall be not less than three days"

On page 3, line 12, after the word 'data' deleting the word 'to' and adding the words "which pertain to the application process or to a complaint investigation. Such inspection may be conducted by"

Senator Steffes moved that SB 563 be amended on page 3 with the amendment provided by the Revisor. Senator Jordan gave a second to the motion. The motion carried.

Senator Steffes recommended SB 563 favorably for passage as amended. Senator Papay gave a second to the motion. The motion carried.

The Committee directed its attention to SB 724--eliminating the requirement of one judge in each county.

Several committee members gave their opinions on what they thought should be done with the bill.

Senator Steffes moved that SB 724 be recommended for interim study. Senator Papay seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Senators Feleciano and Lee were recorded as voting no.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:45 p.m.
