COMMITTEE RULES 1997 Kansas House Environment Committee

- Treat everyone with respect.
- 2. The chair reserves the right to limit testimony that is cumulative in nature and may limit testimony, when necessary, to a specific number of minutes.
- 3. Committee members shall not address conferees until recognized by the chair.
- 4. No conferee shall be interrupted during presentations of their testimony, except with the permission of the chair.
- 5. Questioning of a conferee shall be limited to the subject matter of the agenda item for the day, except as may be otherwise allowed by the chair.
- 6. No bill or resolution shall be taken up for a committee vote unless it is on the daily agenda or announced by the chair.
- 7. Original motions shall be in order when a bill is pending for consideration. A substitute motion will not be allowed. Amendments to motions are not in order. Amendments to amendments are not in order.
- 8. Amendments to bills should be in written form.
- 9. A motion to report a bill "without recommendation" shall not be in order.
- 10. A motion to table or take from the table shall be in order only when such item is on the agenda or is taken up by the chair. The motion requires a simple majority and is, unless otherwise determined by the chair, non-debatable.
- 11. A request from any member that their own vote be recorded shall be granted.
- 12. Granting excused absences is reserved to the chair.
- 13. Adjournment is reserved to the chair.
- 14. All powers, duties, and responsibilities not addressed above are reserved to the chair.
